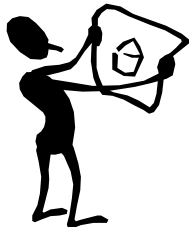

PLANNING COMMITTEE.

There has been a slight increase in the number of planning Applications received from the Planning and Development Department within East Riding of Yorkshire Council for the villages of Ganstead, Bilton and Wyton.

During the period January to November 2013 Bilton Parish Council received 24 planning applications.

As consultees within the planning process we returned our comments on all the applications to the case officer dealing with the project within the agreed time scales.

We received two controversial applications, each one to erect a wind turbine within the neighbouring village of Thirtleby. Each proposal was to erect a 75m tall turbine measured from floor to tip of blade. Fortunately one has since been withdrawn but could be resubmitted at a later date.

The other still awaiting a decision from ERYC will dominate the local sky line if granted.

Bilton Parish Council has submitted their comments which are to reject the application.

An application for change of use to a dwelling was received and granted for the Methodist Church at Wyton. This grade 11 listed building built in 1841 within the Wyton conservation area had been surplus to requirements since 2009. The change of use will ensure the building retains all its unique character.

An ongoing controversial application to develop land on a green field site at Ganstead East was rejected at an appeals hearing. The decision had total support from all the residents of Ganstead East and West and Bilton Parish Council.

The remaining applications received were for home extensions.

Again during the course of the year the Council with the assistance of the local Police, have con-

ducted a series of Community Speedwatch events, covering Holmes Lane, Main Road and Preston Lane. A total of approximately 50 vehicles have been logged as driving a speeds upwards of 35 mph in the 30 mph zones. These people have been reminded by letter from the Police about the need to reduce speeds. The worst culprit was logged at 52 mph.

It is intended to continue to monitor the traffic issues again next year under the Community scheme, so motorists please remember to keep within the prescribed limits for the safety of all other road users.
